

How to separate and dispose of garbage

Please refer to this if you are unsure how to separate your garbage.

Burnable garbage

put it in a bag

- kitchen waste ※ drain the water
- plastic products (Small items)
- paper box
- clothing · shoes
- Styrofoam ※ Items under 30cm
- stick
- CD
- hand warmer
- disposable diapers ※ Remove excrement

Non-burnable garbage

don't put it in a bag

- pottery
- Fluorescent lamps/light bulbs ※ things made of glass
- glass tableware ※ Heat-resistant glass included
- Plate glass · mirrors ※ Items under 30cm
- cosmetic jar

Put in the collection box

Steel cans · small metal items

don't put it in a bag

- steel cans
- knives etc. ※ Wrap it in a towel to prevent injury
- Small metal items
- syringe needle

Put in the collection box

× cannot be collected

Items that may catch fire

put it in a bag

※ Lithium-ion batteries,

- dry battery
- button battery
- lighter ※ Use up the contents
- spray can ※ Be sure to release the gas
- handy fan
- shaver
- mobile battery
- electronic cigarette
- lithium ion battery

※ Lithium-ion battery built-in products (Items under 30cm)

Put it in the bag and put it in the collection box

Bulky trash

※ Cut the electrical cord ※ Remove the glass
※ Remove the lithium-ion battery or other batteries

- 8 Lithium-ion battery built-in products (Over 30cm)**

 - Solar-powered light
 - Hand-cranked battery radio
- 9 Others**
 - hose
 - wire hanger
 - electrical cord
 - umbrella

Put in the collection box near the sign

- tv set
- air conditioner
- washing machine
- refrigerator
- computer

Please ask a home appliance retailer to collect the four types of home appliances.

Waste paper

Tie with vinyl string

- newspaper
- Magazines
- cardboard
- milk carton

Bundle by type

Aluminum cans

don't put it in a bag

Items with a mark

After compressing

Put in the collection box

Plastic bottle

don't put it in a bag

Items with a mark

Remove the cap and label and wash with water

Don't compress

Put into a drum

Bottles

don't put it in

Remove the cap and rinse with water

Put into a drum

- white/colorless bottle → Colorless
- brown bottle → Brown
- Other colored bottles → Blue Green black

Heat-resistant glass and cosmetic bottles are "non-burnable waste"

- ① Please put out your garbage at the garbage station by 8:30am.
- ② Put "Burnable garbage" and "Items that may catch fire" in transparent bags.
- ③ Bulky waste will not be disposed of at the usual garbage station.
- ④ Tie cardboard boxes with string and put them out on paper recycling day.
- ⑤ Please separate your garbage properly and do not put it out on any other days.
- ⑥ Do not dispose of lithium-ion batteries or small appliances containing batteries in combustible waste.
